

Side Tilt Carriages

Side Tilt Carriage - Rated by the blade carriage lifting capacity, there are four sizings of hook type tine carriages. The hook type fork carriages have been standardized.

The carriage bar spacing for Class 1 is approximately 13 inches and the Class 1 carriage is rated to hold cargo as much as 2000lbs. The Class 2 carriage is rated to carry cargo up to 5,500lbs with carriage bar spacing of sixteen inches. Class III carriages are rated for loads up to 10,000 lbs. The carriage bar spacing for this particular class is 20 inches. Class IV carriages are rated for loads as much as 15,500 lbs. The carriage bar spacing for this capacity is 25 inches.

Pin mounted tines differ by the amount of offset between the blade and the tine eye. Different manufacturers will vary the carriages for pin type tines. Carriage capacity will be established by the carriage pin size and by the blade size.
